REPORT

Introduction

The four years Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) Arts Stream and Science Stream is offered after Senior Secondary (+2) and aims at preparing committed, responsible and professional teachers. This programme is intended to result in a paradigm shift in teacher preparation. This programme integrates general studies comprising Mathematics and Science, Social Sciences and Humanities and also professional studies comprising perspectives in education, other core education courses, curriculum and pedagogy of school subjects and practicum related to the tasks and functions of a school teacher. It maintains a balance between theory and practice and ensures coherence and integration among the various components of the programme. It is expected to equip the aspirant school teacher with the requisite attitude, skills and knowledge to address the challenges of becoming an effective school teacher

The introduction of a four year ITEP such as B.Sc B.Ed & B.A B.Ed poses a range of challenges to teacher educators and colleges. Challenges to the curriculum implementation are identified like teaching of pedagogy, difficulties in evaluation and internship etc. Therefore Teacher Educators and administrators face difficulties and problems for implementing ITEP. Since this is a novel venture it is intended to develop a handbook for implementing ITEP by the IUCTE, RIEM.

Day Wise proceedings of the workshop

Day -1

This workshop was attended by experts from State and central University of Southern region. Dr S. Prasannakumar, Associate Professor of Science Education and Coordinator of the workshop welcomed the members. In his welcome speech, he gave brief account of the concept note of the workshop. He explained how the programme is planned, what are the elements are to be considered, what is expected for the developing handbook and how best it can be reached to the end users.

- Theory papers
- Practicum
- Semester system
- Credit system
- Internship
- Scheme of examination

After the discussion the experts have decided to the develop IUCTE proposed model of the course structure will be included in the second chapter of the handbook.

II. Non Scholastic Calendar Activities will focus on Co-curricular Activities.

It will bring the hidden or inherent talents of the student's teachers and brings Self-confidence and develops various psychomotor skills.

1. Club Activities - Language club, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Fine Arts. (Once in 15 days, Afternoon 2 Session of Saturdays can be allotted).

2. Sports Activities - Conducting a Sports meet For 2/3 days in Even semester

3. Working with community - 3 – 5 days
4. Conducting workshops, Debate, Group discussion, Seminar on current Social and Educational issues and Challenges.
5. Grama Seva Activity in Each Semester
6. Celebration of National Festivals
7. Celebration of Environment Day, Teachers Day, Education Day, Gandhi Jayanthi International Women's Day
8. Scientific sentiments behind the rituals and ceremonies has to be explored on all religious festivals like Krishna Jayanthi, Vinayagar Chathurthi, Vijaya Dasami, Diwali, Pongal, Bakrid, Ramzan, X-mas etc,.
