DAY - 1


18th December 2019

- Video lectures to be provided/uploaded if necessary
- PPT also to be provided wherever necessary
- Computer literate/Knowledge is desirable

- Publicity through DSERT and DIET
- Simple language should use while writing the units
- Provide URL link wherever required
- Extra information can added in appendix
- Creation of Library web page/face-book page/blogs for assessment
- Day to day report to be generated during the training programme by the participants.
- Library literacy programme chart can be prepared during the training.
- Prepare a google chart.
- One session to be dedicated for skill development/ soft skill etc. other than library science.

OUTCOMES

- A manual with its contents and units were ready.
- The next activity after the editing of content of the manual by the experts the training programme for 30 to be conducted in February 2020.

Suggestions that evolved regarding the trining programme

- Training programme to be practical oriented
- Minimum qualification is bachelor's degree with the knowledge of library science.
